Chairperson's Update - K. Romany

- Debrief from Halloween Dance + Pumpkins
 - Total cost of Halloween dance + pumpkins was \$413.97 (\$300 for DJ John, \$113.97 for pumpkins and chips).
 - ➤ Budget was \$600, Thanks to \$50 in gift card donations (Loblaws, No Frills) and savings from price matching and a small donation (box of chips) from No Frills, we came in \$186.03 under budget; which will be reallocated to other items within our budget.
 - Lunch programs
 - > K. Romany spoke to Pizza Nova, (note, we have tried many different pizza providers over the years, Pizza Nova has been the only store who provides the quality and service we need for the size of our school)
 - Cost of jumbo pizza is \$15.82 for 12 slices. If we sell each slice for \$2.50 (same as the past few years) we would make a profit of \$1.18 per slice.
 - > Order lead time is 1 week
 - ➤ K. Romany to work with Isabel to determine a pizza distribution plan (based on # volunteers)
 - Targeting to launch 3 sessions (pending volunteer availability):
 - Session 1 (8 weeks) Dec 2 Feb 10.
 - Session 2 (8 weeks) Feb 24 Apr 28.
 - Session 3 (8 weeks) May 5 June 23.
 - Parish Family Christmas

- ➤ K. Romany will work with Isabel (in collaboration with our parish) to support of our families that we help out during the holiday season.
- > Typically we solicit cash donations from the school community, with the funds raised we buy gift cards to local stores (e.g. Walmart, superstore etc.) and these are distributed to families in need within our school and parish community.
- Valentines Dance Tuesday Feb 14 2023
 - > CSC will host a dance and distribute cookies to all students.
 - ➤ We have \$900 in the budget, however, we likely need approx. \$500 (\$300 for DJ, \$200 for cookies). Savings will again be redistributed to other line items within budget.
 - > K. Romany will regroup with council via email for planning of this event
 - ➤ School is planning to sell cookies for shared life CSC to decide if we also want to give cookies or some other treat
- Shrove Tuesday Tuesday Feb 21 2023
 - This is the largest/most complex event we hold at the school.
 - Need approx. 10-15 volunteers (to mix batter, cook pancakes, distribute to students)
 - > K. Romany will regroup with council via email for planning for this event.
- Exec Training night has been rescheduled for Dec 1. K. Romany to share more details with the exec council members as it becomes available.
