Administrative:

- Pavement not for another 2-3 year
- Further to the site inspection conducted on April 18, 2023 at the roundabout at Churchill Meadows Boulevard and Rosanna/Escada Drive for the students attending St. Bernard of Clairvaux Catholic Elementary School. The recommendation noted below will be considered at the Mississauga School Traffic Safety Action Committee on Thursday, April 27, 2023. These recommendations will then be subsequently adopted at Council on May 17, 2023.

RECOMMENDATION

- That the warrants have not been met for the placement of a school crossing guard at Churchill Meadows Boulevard and Rosanna/Escada Drive for the students attending St. Bernard of Clairvaux Catholic Elementary School.
- That Transportation and Works be requested to remove the roundabout at Churchill Meadows Boulevard and Rosanna/Escada Drive and instead install stop signs on the side streets Rosanna Drive and Escada Drive.
- That Transportation and works review the feasibility of creating an all way stop controlled intersection at Churchill Meadows Boulevard and Rosanna/Escada Drive.
- That Mississauga School Traffic Safety Action Committee be requested to reinspect the intersection of Churchill Meadows Boulevard and
 Rosanna/Escada Drive once part 2 of the recommendation has taken
 place to determine if the warrants are met for the implementation of a school
 crossing guard.
- **Shuttering** we will be shuttering seven classrooms next year. This is a board initiative to save on Energy costs. Happens as the school is shrinking.

- Portables a request has been made to remove the two portables in the primary yard. Plant has said they will attempt to demolish or move them this summer – not guaranteed.
- Basketball Nets installed this week (need locates first)
